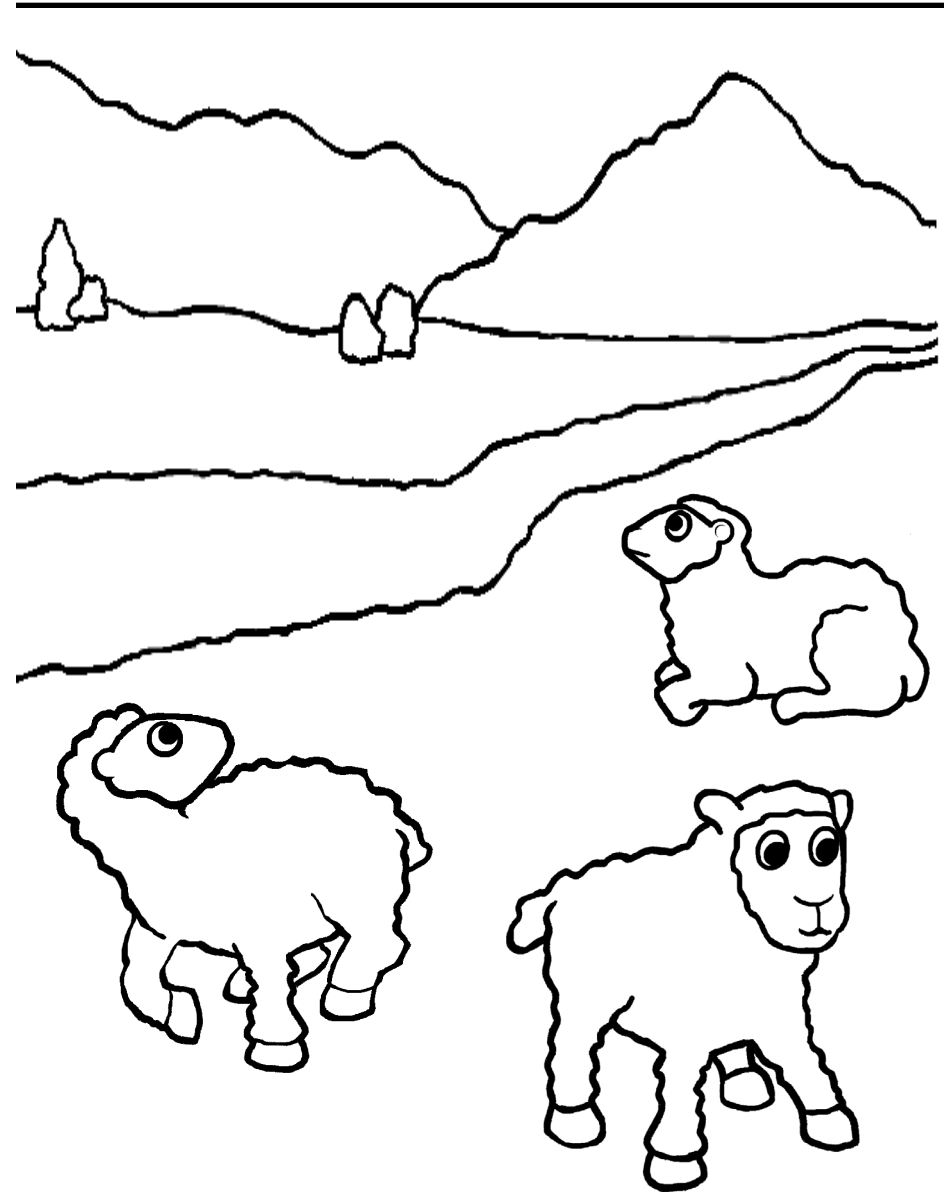

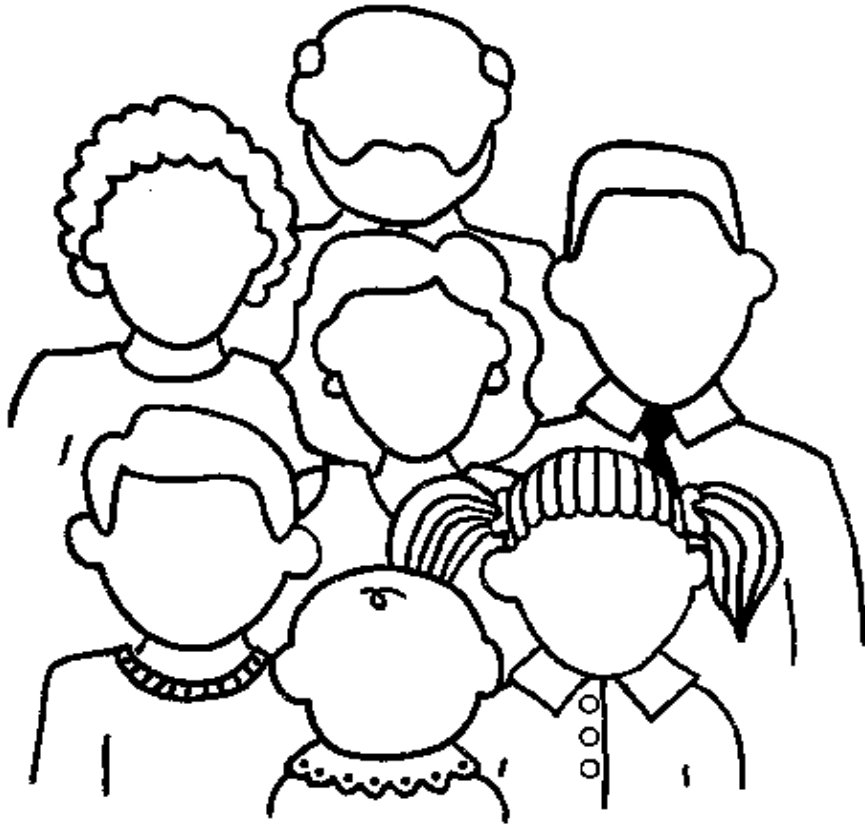

— Sheep only eat chocolate chip cookies. They don't like any other kind of foods.

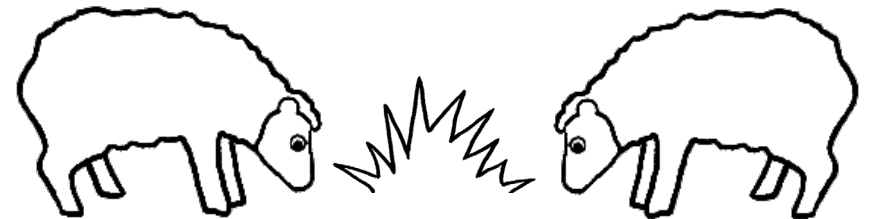
— When sheep are sick, they will eat certain plants or grasses to help feel better.
