Now he told a **parable** to those who were **invited**, when he **noticed** how they **chose** the **places** of **honor**, saying to them, “When you are invited by someone to a **wedding feast**, do not **sit** down in a place of honor, lest someone more **distinguished** than you be invited by him, and he who invited you both will come and say to you, ‘**Give** your place to this person,’ and then you will begin with **shame** to take the **lowest** place. But when you are invited, go and sit in the lowest place, so that when your **host** comes he may say to you, ‘**Friend, move up higher.**’ Then you will be honored in the **presence** of all who sit at **table** with you. For everyone who **exalts** himself will be **humbled**, and he who **humbles** himself will be **exalted.**”

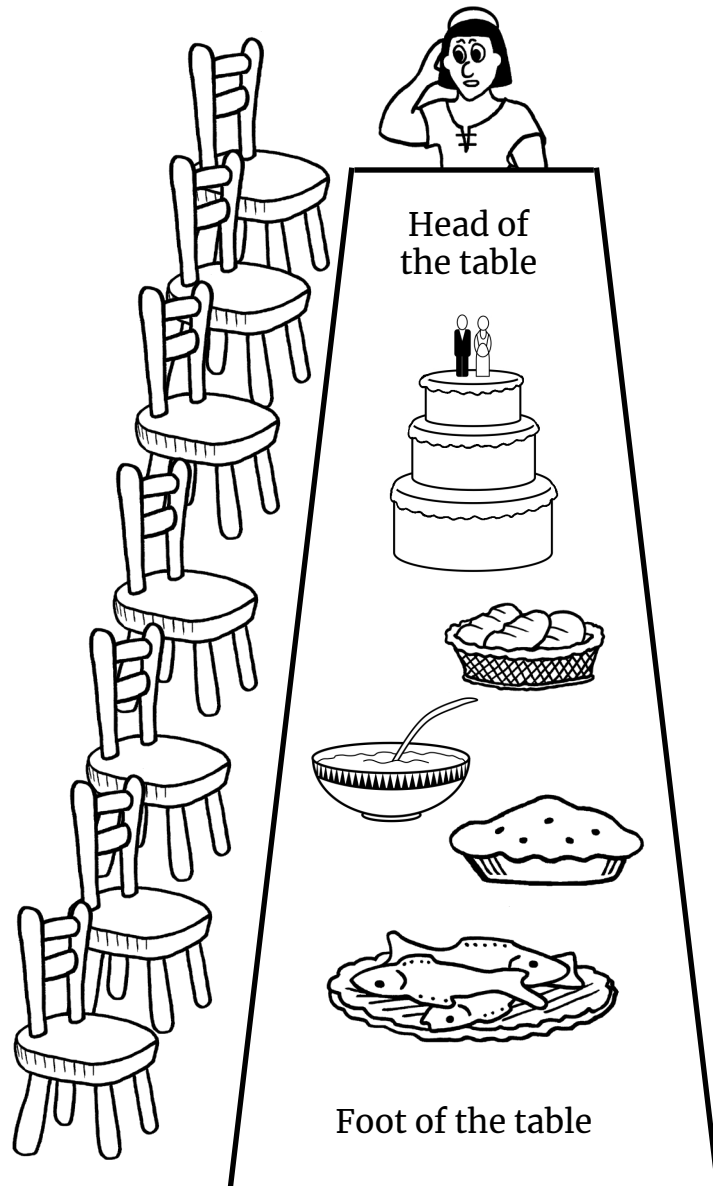
It is always wise to be humble--even at a feast.
