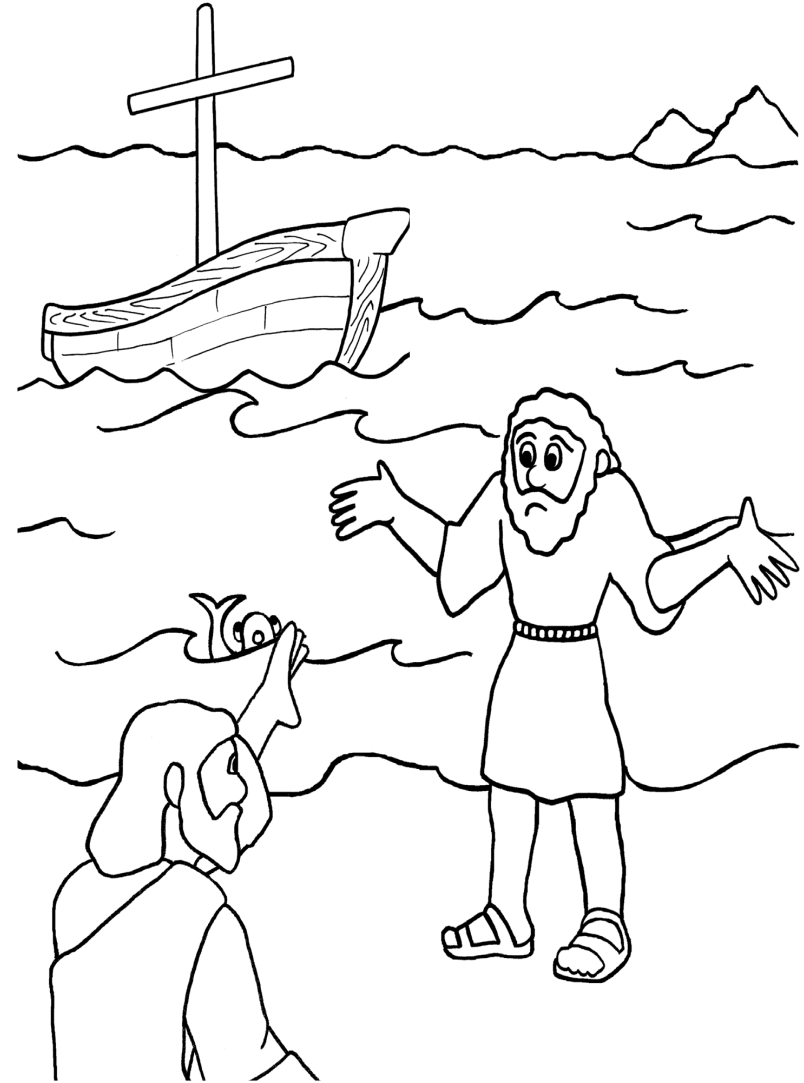

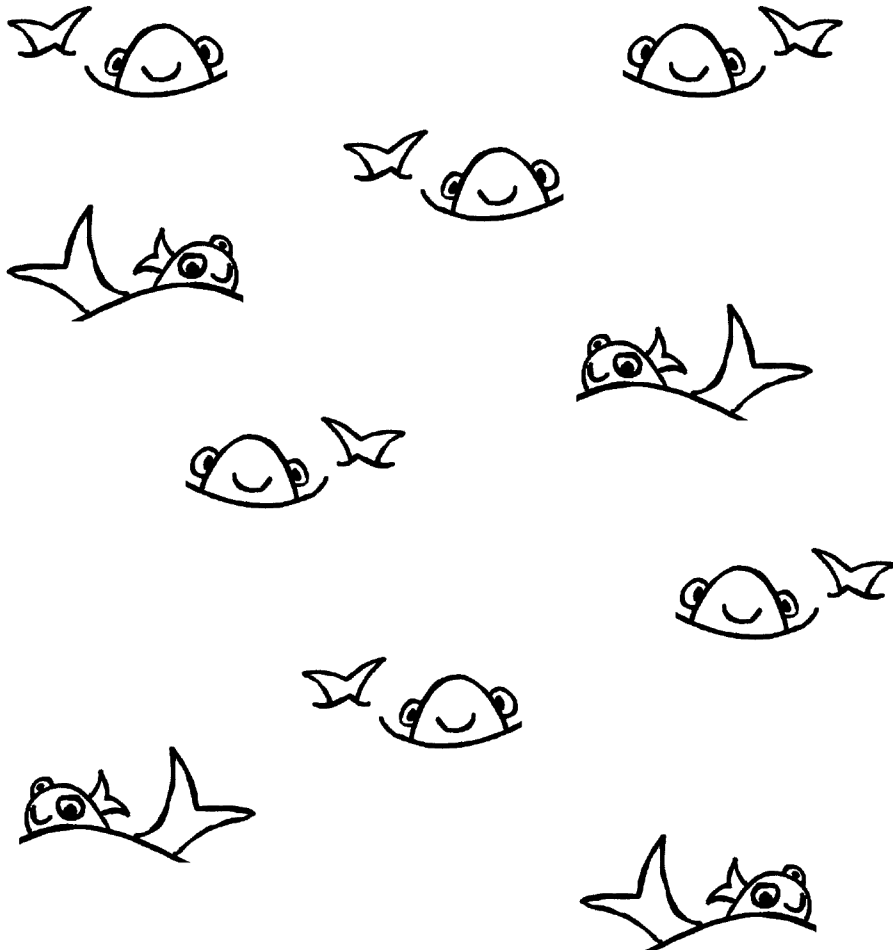


Jesus told Peter to go fishing again. But Peter wasn't so sure.
