My dad was an extremely tolerant man however, when it came to me and Christmas, his tolerance seemed to be missing. His cry "how long Tim!?" The "how long" came to fruition Christmas morning. I ran down the stairs running over my sister and brother, tearing open the presents in full exhilaration and then, it was over. Just like that it was over. Just like that came the cry, "how long dear God till next Christmas!?" My dad was not happy with me.
