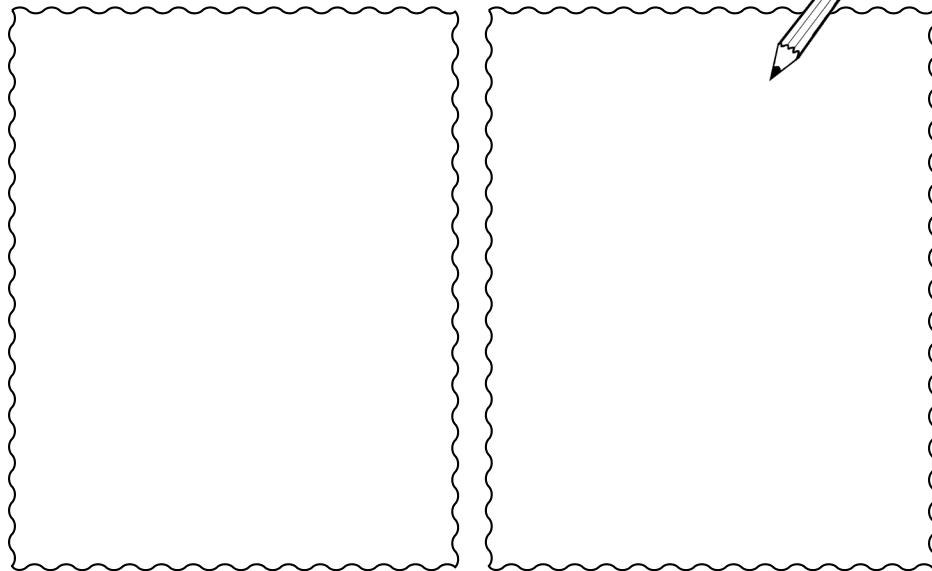

Draw three of the brightest things you know.

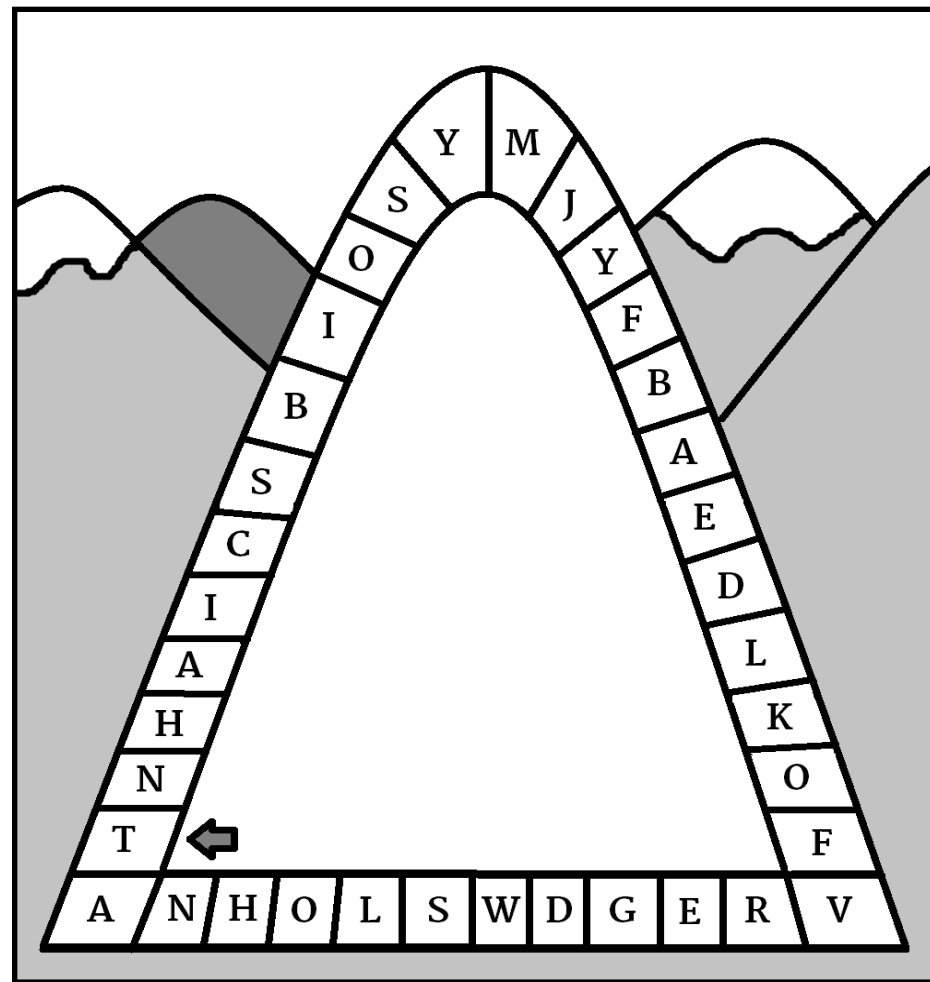


God's glory is far brighter than these things!
