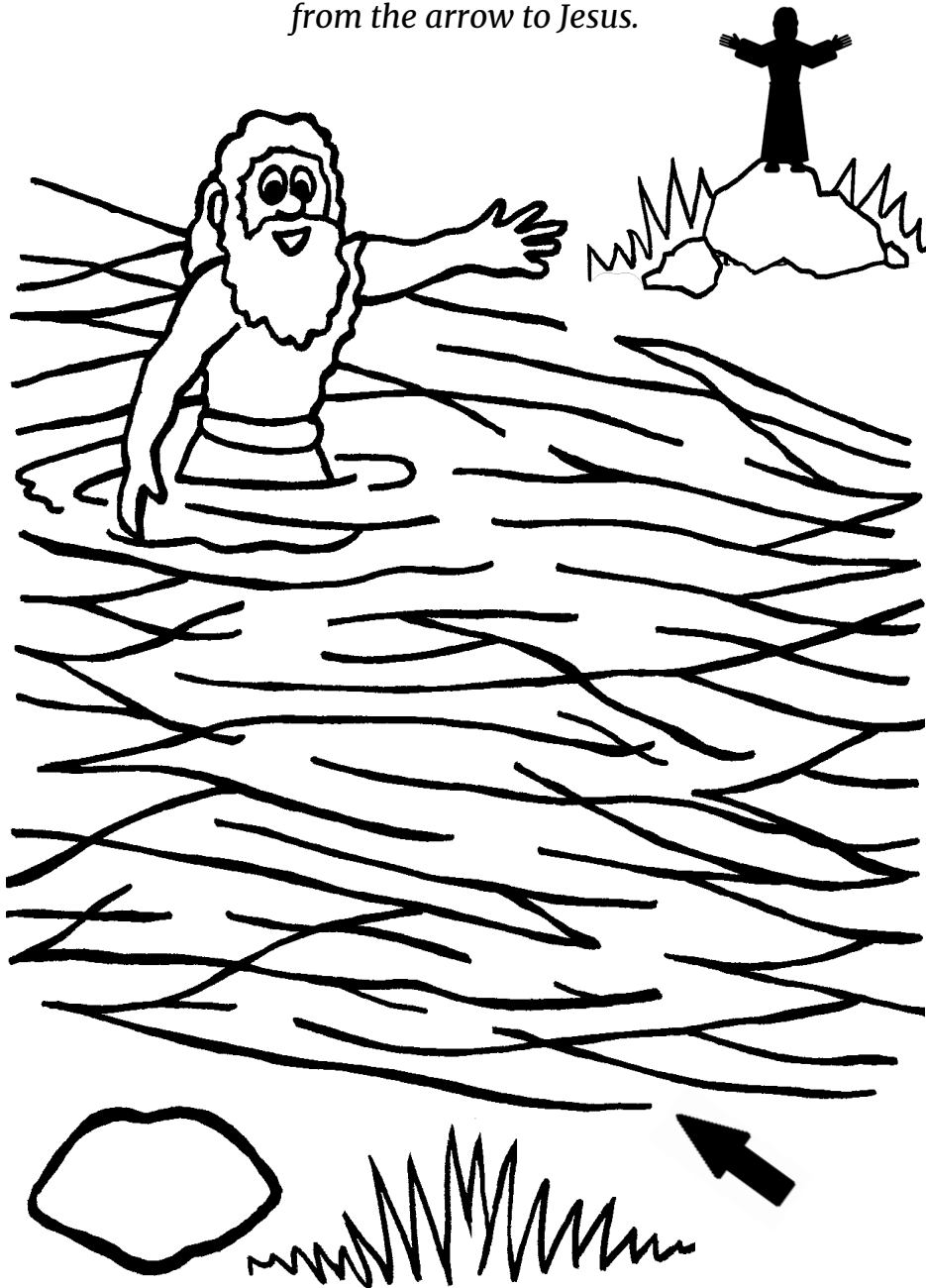


The Holy Spirit helped John the Baptist realize that Jesus was God's Son.

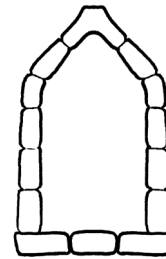
John the Baptist is ready to baptize more people!

Count all the different sources of light that you see!*



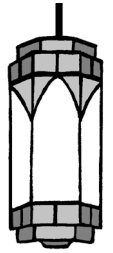
