Message from Pastor Mike



MEET PASTOR MIKE

For those of you who have not met me yet, and for those of you who have, I would like to give a brief introduction. My name is Michael Tamorria, and I have been a Lutheran pastor for 43 I have been a member of the NALC since 2010. I am one of a number of pastors under call by the NALC to act as interim pastors for churches like Cross that between pastors. Cross is the seventh interim I have served, and the second in Michigan (the other was Peace Lutheran in St. Joseph). As such, I report to Bishop John Bradosky and his assistant. Pastor David Wendel.

In a way, all pastors are interims. Eventually, any pastor of any church will either move, retire, or die. Only Jesus, the Good Shepherd, remains forever. As an intentional interim, my duties fall into two main categories. The first is to assist the Council, the Call Committee, and the congregation with the process leading up to the call of a new pastor. The other is to do the regular duties of a pastor on a temporary basis: counsel the afflicted, visit the sick and shut-in, lead worship, teach confirmation, help administer the congregation, and so on. How long this will all take is unknown. On an average, you could expect a new pastor by next Lent. But sometimes it moves more quickly and sometimes more slowly.

I will only be here on a part-time basis, roughly 10-11 days per month, including two Sundays. The Sundays I am here will be noted in the bulletins and newsletters. will have communion on the Sundays when I am here to keep up your previous pattern of two Sundays a month. I will also lead the Wednesday service when I am in Pigeon.

The rest of the time, I live in the tiny community of Chattanooga, Ohio, which you won't find on a lot of maps and doesn't even rate a post office. It's about an hour southeast of Fort Wayne, Indiana, and about a half-mile east of the Ohio/Indiana state line. My wife Karen is also an NALC pastor and

serves two country congregations, St. John's, Hopewell Township, and Zion, Chattanooga.

I have one son, Andy, who just turned 40, and two grand-daughters, Ella and Zoe, presently 10 and 8 years old. They live in Pittsburgh. I also have a sister who lives in Bowie, Maryland, where her sons and grandchildren also reside.

Please be patient with me. It will take me time to learn all your names and how everyone fits in with God's family here at Cross. Given the relatively brief time I may be here, I will probably never quite get it all. But that's OK. The important thing is that God knows who we all are and blesses us with His love. This church is more important to Him than it is to any of us; you are His people for whom His Son gave His life.

I look forward to working with you all and learning about God's ministry here in Pigeon, Michigan.
